



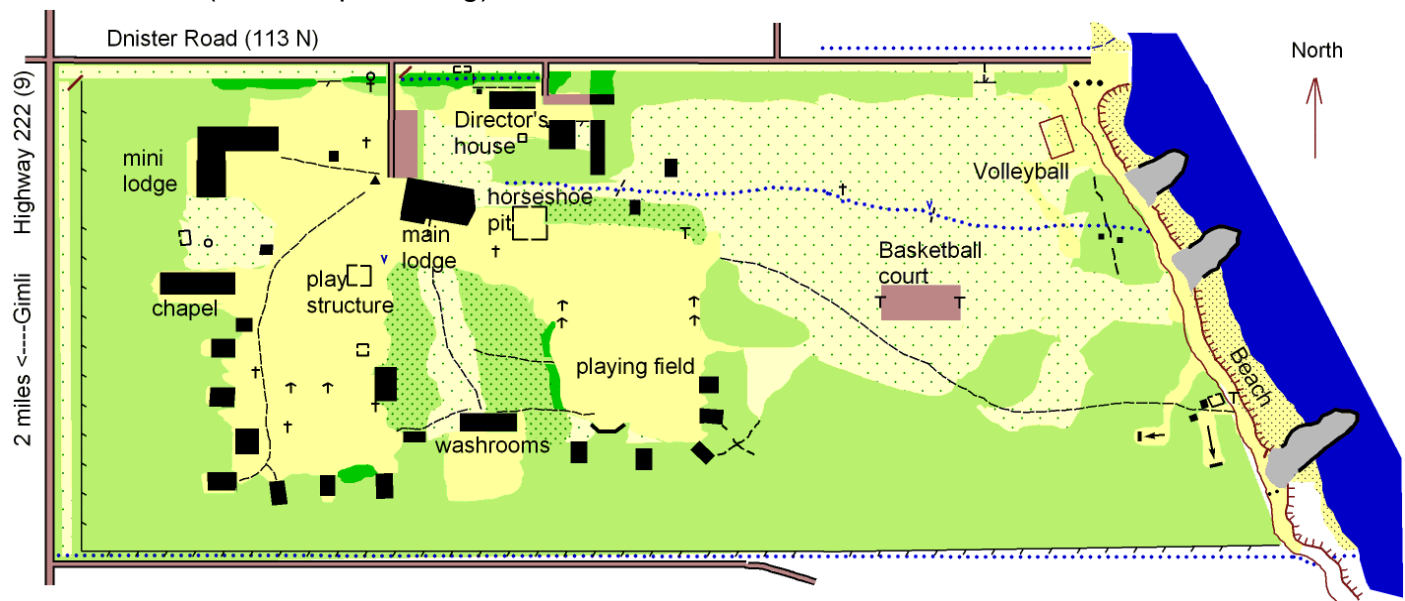

RENTAL INFORMATION

Gimli Bible Camp is located 3.5 km North of Gimli on Hwy 9 (route 222), on the shores of Lake Winnipeg. The camp is owned and operated by the Canadian Sunday School Mission, and is one of 6 CSSM camps in Manitoba. We are situated on approximately 11 acres of park-like treed land with a mixture of modern and original buildings. We offer groups a facility only (on site catering may be possible, enquire) for 20-175 people

Site:

- *Lodge with kitchen and dining hall / meeting hall facilities as well as 8 second floor lodge rooms which have male and female washrooms for 26 guests
- *Mini lodge with 5 rooms sleeping 4 each, single washroom and single shower.
- *10 roomy heated cabins with bunks to hold 14 people each.
- *Exterior washroom building with 3 showers per side
- *Large basement rec room and meeting room
- *Chapel/meeting area (not heated)
- *Meeting room (separate building- unheated) for 20-25
- *Fire pit area (wood provided)
- *2 medium size playing fields
- *Beach area
- *Canoe rental (weather permitting)



Available for church and para-Church organizations, youth groups, retreats, family gatherings, banquets, anniversaries, meetings, etc.

Rental Policies

The facilities at Gimli Bible Camp have been developed by the voluntary gifts and labours of many people who are interested in sharing the Good News found in God's Word—The Bible. The camp is owned by the Canadian Sunday School Mission. (CSSM). The purpose of CSSM is to present and promote the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. Regulations governing the use of our camp state "*all Mission Camps are BIBLE CAMPS and must be maintained as such.*" Therefore, it is the policy that all camp facilities, when not used for our own programs, be made available at a reasonable rent to those organizations and groups who share the same purposes and beliefs as our own. **Rental groups must read and agree with the CSSM *Mission Statement* (attached).**

1. Contact person for each rental group is responsible for acquainting themselves and other leaders of the Rental Policies, which govern the rental group. They are also responsible to be sure that these regulations are followed by the participants and are responsible for any damage to camp property.
2. No alcoholic beverages or drugs not prescribed by a physician can be brought with the group or consumed on our property.
3. We seek to maintain a "smoke free" environment. If some group members must smoke, we ask that it be off camp property.
4. Cabin groups made up of campers who are 18 years of age or under, must have an adult leader residing in the cabin with those groups.
5. Dances are not to be held on the camp property.
6. We suggest that all groups have a knowledgeable first aid person, preferably a registered nurse, in their core of leaders. Our nurse's station is available for use by that person. We also ask that all groups come with the basic first aid supplies (bandages, antiseptic, burn cream or ointment, tensor bandages, etc.) Gimli Hospital is 3 miles from our site.
7. Gimli Bible Camp cannot be responsible for accidents and sickness incurred by our rental groups. Therefore, groups need to provide accident / liability insurance that will cover their campers/participants and staff.
8. Program areas and facilities used by the group must be under the supervision of a leader competent in the activity and knowledgeable of the safety factors involved.
9. Any damages to camp property above normal wear and tear will be invoiced to the group as soon as repairs can be made.
10. Our rental rates are based on the expectation that groups will leave the camp as clean as they found it on arrival. Groups are expected to use our "Rental checkout list" prior to departure. Groups are expected to plan their schedule with enough time to accomplish this list.
11. Pets are not permitted.
12. If swimming is part of the program, the rental group must supply an adult supervisor for the waterfront.
13. Fires may be built in fire pit area only.
14. No defacing property or cutting down trees.

Each person of the group is to be made aware of the above and aware that immoral conduct, profanity, or unsafe conduct, as determined by the Gimli Bible Camp staff, could result in termination of rental contract and they may be asked to leave the premises.

Procedure sheets (dishes, clean up, grill cleaning, etc) will be made available upon arrival.



MISSION STATEMENT

The purpose of CSSM Ministries is to present and promote the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ, primarily to the otherwise unreached in Canada, to the end that the lost shall be evangelized, and that Christian believers shall be taught and strengthened in the faith.

- 2.** The doctrine of the Trinity, one God revealed as Father, Son and Holy Spirit, Creator of all things, infinitely perfect.
- 3.** The Deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, His miraculous conception, humanity, miracles, bodily resurrection, ascension and return.
- 4.** The personality of the Holy Spirit whose ministry is to glorify the Lord Jesus Christ and during this age to convict men, regenerate the believing sinner, indwell, guide, instruct and empower the believer for godly living and service.
- 5.** The total depravity of man who was created in the image of God, that he sinned and thereby incurred not only physical death but also spiritual death; and that all human beings are born with a sinful nature and are incapable of pleasing God, and in the case of those who reach moral responsibility become culpable sinners, utterly lost, and only through being born again through faith in our Lord Jesus Christ, in whom we have redemption through His blood, can salvation and spiritual life be obtained.
- 6.** The resurrection of the body, the eternal life of the saved, the eternal punishment of the lost; after death all men continue in conscious existence, the believers being "absent from the body but present with the Lord." The lost in everlasting conscious torment.
- 7.** The personality of Satan as a created being and an adversary of God.

Rental Costs (2009)

To keep the camp affordable we will continue to charge only \$14.00 per person per day.

Minimum charge per day is \$250 for March, April and October 14 to December 18
\$350 per day for December 19-February 28, May 1st to Thanksgiving

Special rate of \$10.00 per day for children under 18 on weekdays

The months of July and August are reserved for our summer camp program.

2 Day Weekend Rental (Friday 4:30 pm to Sunday 4:30 pm)

*Cost or rental of site is per day for all in attendance over the age of 6 (campers, volunteers, directors, kitchen personnel, visitors) this includes:

- the use of the kitchen and kitchen equipment
- lodging (see site plan) with consideration given to wise use of space (e.g. for a youth camp – filling all beds in a cabin before using another)
- dining hall area, grounds, general maintenance items.

One Day Rental (24 hr period)

*Cost or rental is per person for all in attendance over the age of 6 as above

Day Time Rental (e.g. 9:00 am – 6:00 pm)

*Cost \$110 site charge

*Kitchen use an additional \$50

Banquet Rental (over one mealtime)

*Cost \$110 this includes:

- the use of kitchen and dining hall area
- use of all kitchen equipment
- use of tables and chairs that are available

Evening Rental (e.g. 7:00pm – 9:00 pm)

*Cost \$2.00 per person (everyone in attendance over the age of 6)

-minimum charge of \$40.00

All site costs include a staff (host) from Gimli Bible Camp. Their responsibility will be to have the site clean for your arrival, to keep washrooms supplied with paper, to take out the garbage, to help run or instruct in the operation of the dishwasher, and to help the group with any questions or concerns they may have. They will help organize and have supplies ready for site clean up before the group leaves, and to make possible repairs to damaged camp property if needed.

The rental group is responsible for feeding the host and his/her family, when present. Groups must have adequate insurance or make use of Gimli's insurance coverage.
