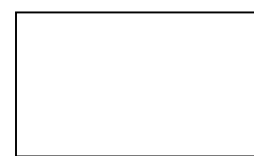

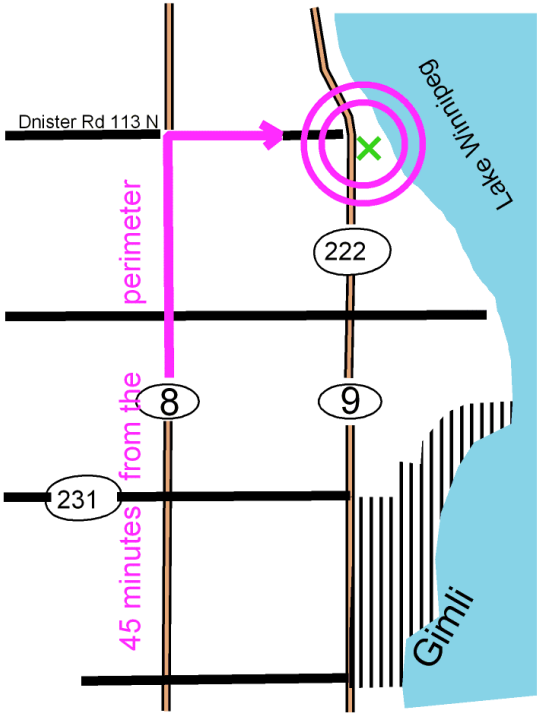

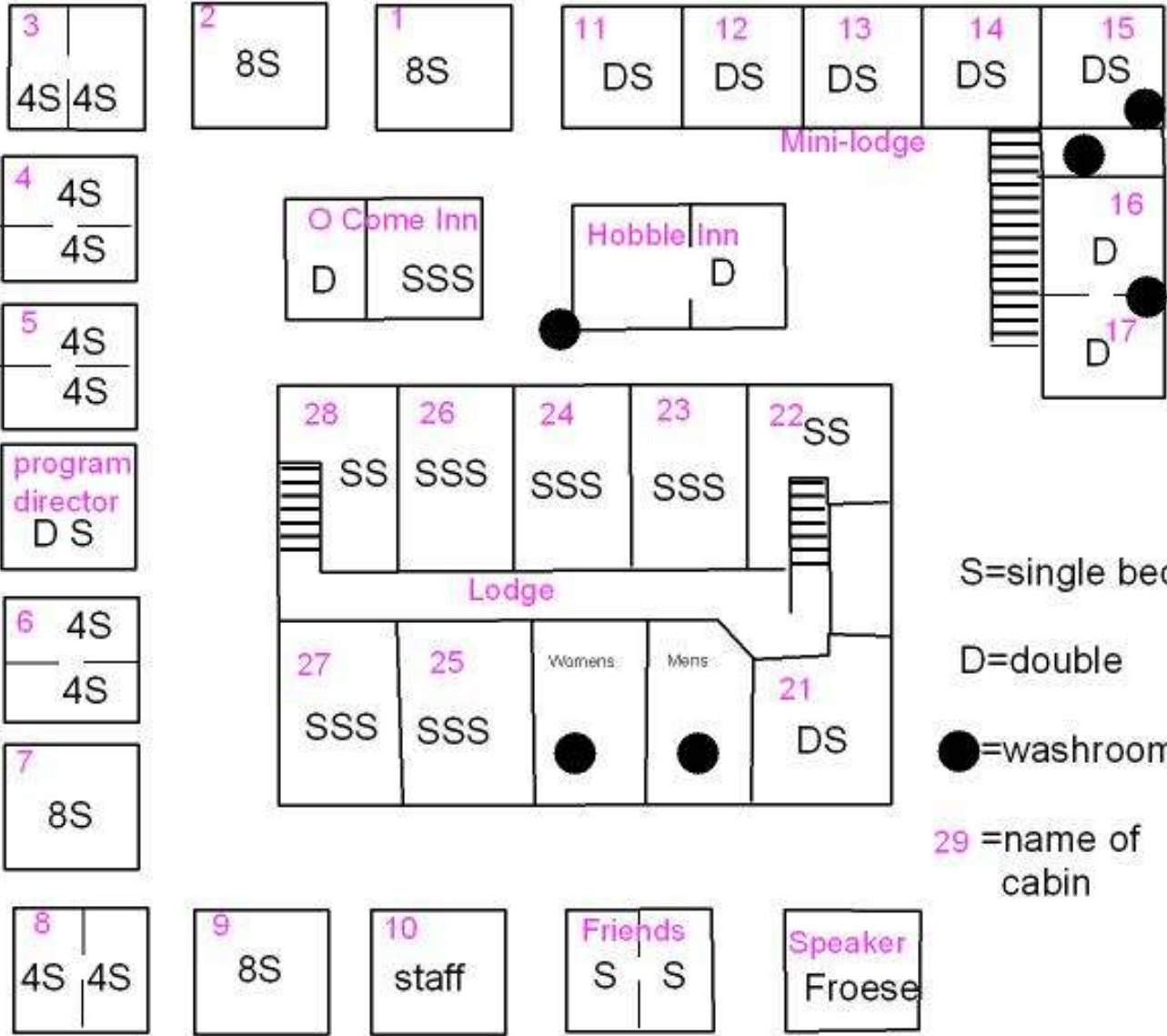
Accommodations will be first-come, first served but we will work to ensure that everyone's physical needs are met. Please choose our cabin (1-9) accommodations if you are physically able.
